

MNR gang kills 18 in Inhambane

INHAMBANE

(Mozambique).

THE South African-backed "Mozambique National Resistance", bandits massacred at least 18 people on Tuesday here.

According to eye-witnesses contacted by AIM, the killings occurred when an MNR gang attacked a convoy of 20 vehicles travelling on the main road from Maputo to Inhambane city.

The attack took place at Chongola, about eight kilometres north of the town of Inharrime, north of Maputo.

Among the victims was a four-year-old child whose body was found inside a bus in the convoy, still clutching a packet of biscuits in her hands.

Also among the dead were two drivers working for the Disasters Control Office, the body that provides humanitarian assistance to people suffering from hunger in Mozambique. — Ziana-AIM.
