

Landmine deaths

ZIANA reports that three Zimbabweans were killed in a landmine accident in Mozambique on Wednesday. One of those killed was Mr Arthur Evans (35) of Bulawayo.

A family spokesman said Mr Evans, who was employed by a Zimbabwean engineering company, E. C. Leaning, was operating a tamping machine on a railway line in Mozambique when the machine detonated a landmine. Two others, also believed to be from Bulawayo, were killed in the accident. The spokesman for the Evans family said Mr Arthur Evans would be buried in Bulawayo on Monday.
