

● Seven missionaries captured by the Mozambique National Resistance (MNR) were released in Malawi on 18 August. The seven — an Australian, an American and five Zimbabweans — were captured from a mission farm near the town of Gondola in May (AED 27:5:87). In a statement issued in Zimbabwe — which with Australia, Malawi and the US, helped to arrange the release — the seven said they had been relatively well treated. According to reports from Lisbon on the day of the release, the MNR attacked the town of Inharrime in Inhambane province, killing nine people and wounding six.
