

Kidnapped nurse tells of prayer with rebels

Kindra Bryan says she spent time praying with her rebel captors in Mozambique and felt she had accomplished her purpose "to share the love of Jesus Christ."

In a press conference Saturday

less than a day after her return to Houston, the 27-year-old nurse said she found strength through Christ which enabled her to endure her three months of captivity

Bryan told reporters that "Many of the soldiers responded to what we had to say about Jesus Christ.

"We asked them if they would pray with us. They asked us if they should take their guns off. They kneeled down. They wanted to pray."

She said it was "hard to say" if she had changed the lives of her captors. "The seed was planted."

"They must be moral people. We never saw any carousing.
