

Minister warns MNR supporters

A SIGNIFICANT number of Mozambicans living in Zimbabwe along the border with that country have been found to be sympathising with MNR bandits and supplying them with information used in attacks on targets in the province.

The Zanu (PF) Secretary for Security, who is also the Minister of State (Security), Cde Emerson Munangagwa, has advised farmers living along the Zimbabwe-Mozambique border against employing Mozambique nationals without first consulting the party.

Cde Munangagwa, who is accompanied on a two-week tour of the province with seven other members of the Central Committee, and the Mozambican Minister of Security, Cde Mariano Matosha, said that a significant number of Mozambicans working on estates close to the border were sympathising with the South African-backed MNR bandits.
