

101 MNR killed

MAPUTO. — The Mozambican armed forces killed 101 armed bandits between 25 August and 1 September in the provinces of Inhambane, Manica, Sofala, Zambezia and Cabo Delgado, according to the armed forces radio programme *Voz de Combate*, broadcast every Sunday.

Yesterday's programme said that in the same period, the Mozambican army destroyed 11 bandit camps that were used to store ammunition and to detain kidnapped civilians. The army captured

nine bandits and a variety of war materials and freed 1241 people who are now receiving assistance under the Mozambican government's emergency relief programme. — *Ziana-AIM-Pana.*
