

Bandits massacre 28

LISBON. — Mozambican MNR bandits attacked a Methodist mission in southern Mozambique this week, killing 28 people and kidnapping many others, the Portuguese news agency Lusa said on Friday.

Quoting military sources in Maputo, it said teachers and nurses were among those kidnapped in the raid on Monday. They worked at the mission's school and hospital in Camine, Inhambane province. The bandits also took medicines from the hospital's dispensary, the report said. — Ziana-Reuters.
