

Rushinga wants more protection

RESIDENTS in Rushinga held a meeting on Wednesday with the Mashonaland Central Governor, Cde Joseph Kaparadza, the local Member of Parliament, Cde Paddington Zvorwadza, and other senior Government officials

to discuss the security situation and other development projects in the area.

Topics discussed included attacks by the South African - backed MNR bandits, who were looting food and murdering civilians in the province.

The people called for the drafting of more members of the police special constabulary, and the construction of permanent police posts along

the border area.

● Four more recent victims of MNR attacks in Rushinga and Mukumbura have been buried.

The recent victims were: Meki Chinyama (14) of Kapfudza village in Mukumbura and Tichaona Drawu (14), Edzai Drawu (8) and Emmanuel Drawu (5) all of Katoni in Rushinga. This brings the number killed by MNR bandits in the area during October to 10. — ZIS.
