

(Excerpts) In Chimoio today, a further 32 citizens who decided to abandon the armed bandits in the service of South Africa were handed over to the Mozambique Red Cross in Manica province. . . This is the second group to be handed over to the Mozambique Red Cross. The first 22 Mozambicans to surrender have either joined their families or returned to their provinces of origin. The second group surrendered with their respective weapons. Also today at the Mozambique Red Cross branch in Manica, a group of armed bandits captured by the joint forces was handed over to the Mozambican authorities. . .
