## SA WAR EXPERT KILLED

45 -1 MAPUTO

MOZAMBICAN and Zimbabwean troops operating against bandits in central Sofala province have killed a South African military specialist, the Beira sewspaper Diario de Mocambique reported at the weekend.

Diario quoted the Mozambican armed fortes political commissar for the province's second military sector as saying the man died in a clash 100 km west of Beira.

The Mozambicans and their Zimbabwean allies overran two camps of the Mozambican National Resistance banding at Nhadongo and Nhanjerain in Nhamatanda district.

The report gave no more details of the South African but said more than 10 rebels were killed, a major from the MNR was captained and a captain surresidered.

The official daily Neitcian said that six people were injured when bandits attacked a passenger train between South Africa and Maputo 40 km from the South African border.

It said Mozambican troops intervened when the bandits opened fire on the train, carrying 2 000 passengers.
