Renamo Rebels Claim Foreign Soldiers Killed AU2605121788 Paris AFP in English 1200 GMT 26 May 88

[Text] Lisbon, May 26 (AFP) — The Mozambique rebel movement RENAMO said Thursday it killed nine government troops, 13 Tanzanian soldiers and two North Korean military advisers in Nampula province last Sunday.

A RENAMO communique issued here named the Koreans as Hatoi Zong and Guiang Koryo.

Next day the rebels sabotaged the railway linking land-locked Zimbabwe to the Mozambican port of Beira and halted all traffic, the statement said.

RENAMO (Mozambique National Resistance) accused Zambian troops stationed in Mozambique of massacring 100 villagers at Tembue and Fingoe in Tete province last Friday.
