Bandits of the South African backed MNR killed at least six people on 10 November when they attacked the railway station at Pessene, 50 kilometres north of Maputo, for the third time in less than a month. In addition to the six murders, the bandits kidnapped an unknown number of civilians, including workers at the station. They damaged the railway line, burned down several nearby houses, 'destroyed railway documents, and stole money from the station's safe.
