

South African backed MNR bandits destroyed 200 metres of the railway line from the northern port of Nacala to the city of Nampula on 11 November. The bandits placed explosives on the track 53 kilometres east of Nampula, and the locomotive, two passenger carriages and five goods wagons were derailed. By 14 November all the components of the train except for one wagon had been put back on the rails. There are no reports of fatalities.
