

**RENAMO Attacks Train Outside Maputo**

[Text] At least 7 people were killed and 41 wounded in a RENAMO [Mozambique National Resistance Movement] attack on a passenger train yesterday on the Ressano Garcia-Maputo line. The ambush, followed by the storming of the train, occurred in the area of (Mauvene), 55 km from the capital.

Railways police say that there may be more dead and wounded. A search of the area was still in progress in the early hours of this morning.

This was the second attack on a passenger train on the same line and in the same area in less than 2 weeks.

Elsewhere, in Gaza Province, RENAMO killed four civilians last Tuesday in an attack on the town of Manuacaze. Several dozen houses and 11 shops were pillaged and destroyed. Over 300 tonnes of cashew nuts stored at a local factory were set on fire and destroyed. In a response to this attack a Mozambican army detachment killed four RENAMO men and captured another two, seizing various weapons.
