

Three civilians were killed and three more wounded when a group of South African backed MNR bandits ambushed a goods train between Mount Xiluvo and Inchope, in Nhamatanda, in the central province of Sofala on 21 April. According to Beira's paper 'Diario de Mocambique', the train had left the headquarters of Nhamatanda district heading for Gondola when it was attacked, at about 10.00 local time. The attack also caused considerable damage to the locomotive.
