

On 30 May, the South African backed MNR bandits attacked the commercial area of Chipenhe, about 15 kilometres from the city of Xai-Xai, capital of Gaza province. No one was killed, but an unspecified number of people were kidnapped and forced to transport the goods stolen by the bandits. The attack began at 23.00 local time and lasted until the early hours of the following morning. The bandits stole goods worth several thousand meticals from a private store. It was the third attack on Chipenhe, which is close to the country's main north-south highway, in less than seven months.
