Mozambique: MNR reports Zimbabwean, Tanzanian and Mozambican troops killed in nationwide fighting (Text) Renamo guerrillas have accused Zimbabwe of sending troops to fight with the Mozambique government in the country's civil war. In a statement from Lisbon, Renamo said thousands of Zimbabwean troops have

entered the country to join in the offensive against its forces. It said they were backed by combat planes, transport aircraft and helicopters. The statement also reported fighting all over the country in which Zimbabwean, Tanzanian and Mozambican troops died. Renamo and the government have drafted separate plans to end the fighting which began shortly after independence in 1975. The two sides can't agree on conditions and have yet to hold direct talks.
