'Rebels airdropped  
for sabotage'

Renamo rebels trained in a neighbouring country, believed to be Malawi, have begun infiltrating Mozambique by air to sabotage economic targets, the Portuguese news agency Lusa reported last week.

An unspecified number of rebels had been dropped by parachute into the northern provinces of Manica and Sofala since October, it was claimed. There had been attacks on armoured food convoys.

Meanwhile the Malawi-Mozambique security commission has begun meeting this week to discuss Malawi's unilateral decision to close the common border two weeks ago.
