

# 'MNR responsible for ceasefire attacks'

THE International Joint Verification Commission monitoring a partial agreement between the Mozambican government and MNR bandits said on Thursday that the bandits were probably responsible for the three violations of the accord that the JVC has so far studied.

The JVC concluded a meeting on Thursday on the violations under the chairmanship of the Italian ambassador, Mr Manfredino Incisa di

The three cases considered were a clash at Motasse in the Limpopo Corridor on January 2, a raid on Manga on the outskirts of Beira on January 5, and sabotage of the Beira-Zimbabwe railway on January 4.

In all three cases, the JVC noted that the bandits denied responsibility, but said that, though there was no direct evidence, the balance of probabilities indicated that they were indeed the culprits. — Ziana-AIM.
