Moz rebels deny killings

MAPUTO. — Mozambican rebels yesterday denied a report that they had killed up to 1 000 people, including children, and decapitated some of the victims in a gruesome rampage through villages in a northern province.

A spokesman for the Mozambique National Resistance said the report was part of a government plot to discredit the rebels before a new round of peace talks begins in Rome. — Sapa-AP
