

Renamo blamed for double death

MAPUTO. — Armed men, believed to be Renamo members, ambushed and killed two Portuguese farmers in the northern province of Cabo Delgado.

The Mozambique news agency AIM said the ambush occurred last week when the pair were driving back to their homes in Montepuez from the capital Pemba.

A nephew of Mr Jose Martins De Carvalho, one of the dead, said armed gangs had attacked small shops owned by his uncle on five occasions. — Sapa
