Yelling and jeers as MPs debate London visit of Dr Caetano

Sir Alec Douglas-Home accused Mr Harold Wilson yesterday of adopting "double standards" over Dr Caetano's visit to Britain. In a bitter Commons debate he answered the Labour leader's criticisms by quoting Mr Wilson's own statements when in office on Portugal and on My Lai.

Mr Wilson had said that after the recent reports of the Mozambique massacre there could be no justification for the feting of Dr Caetano by Mr Heath or for Portugal's presence in Nato.
