Sir, In the light of the massive evidence which has now been published of the massacre of hundreds of people in Wiriyamu and neighbouring villages by the Portuguese army last December, and aware of the acute danger in which the witnesses both black and white now stand, we, as British Catholics, appeal to his Holiness the Pope to intervene vigorously and openly with the Portuguese Government to guarantee a full, public inquiry and to ensure the safety of the witnesses.
