Summary of World Broadcasts, ME/8388/ii, 13 October 1986

Frontline leaders' meeting in Mozambique Presidents Kaunda, Mwinyi, Masire and dos Santos as well as Prime Minister Mugabe arrived in Maputo on 12th October to take part in a summit meeting of frontline leaders, Maputo radio reported, Zaire's Prime Minister, Kengo wa Dondo, had also arrived for a meeting with the frontline leaders after their summit. (Earlier the radio said President Mobutu was expected in Maputo and recalled that at the last frontline meeting Zaire was asked to use the Angolan port of Lobito.) Presidents Machel and dos Santos would also hold talks outside the summit framework on Mozambique-Angolan relations.
