

\$30 000 donated to Machel funeral

ZIMBABWEANS yesterday gave nearly \$30 000 to Zanu (PF) and the Government towards the burial of the late Mozambican President, Cde Samora Machel.

The money was given to the Mozambican ambassador to Zimbabwe, Cde Francisco Madeira, by the Zanu (PF) secretary for administration and Minister of Co-operative Development, Cde Maurice Nyagumbo.

"The Prime Minister and First Secretary and President of Zanu (PF), Cde Mugabe, wishes to commend and thank the individuals and organisations for their comradely spirit and solidarity with

the people of Mozambique generally, and the family of the late President Machel in particular during their long hour of grief and bereavement," said Cde Nyagumbo.

The gift of \$29 879,67 was not the last nor the best tribute Zimbabweans would pay to President Machel, said the minister, adding that the best tribute would be re-dedication in pursuing the ideals of the late President.

Big gifts came from Art Printers Limited which gave \$10 000, Zanu (PF) Harare Province \$8 946,39, Mashonaland East Province \$5 033,37 and the Hindu Society which gave \$1 251.
