MOZAMBIQUE: Intermediaries Ion 13/5/89

Following Assistant Secretary of State (designate) for African Affairs, Herman Cohen's audience with the Senate Foreign Relations Committee on May 4, the State Department said that, "The US is aware of imortant contacts with RENAMO that have been carried out by respected intermediaries with the knowledge of the government of Mozambique". It went on to say, "We strongly support this effort to identify the people and clarify the issues that might lead to peace and normalisation in Mozambique." For its part, RENAMO announced on May 10 in Lisbon that it was "open to political dialogue" and that it "wants to arrive at a complete and ultimate cease-fire as quickly as possible without any prior conditions." Recently, President Joaquim Chissano, who rejected every possiblity of direct negotiation, said that RENAMO was prepared to accept him as President but that it wanted several ministerial portfolios for its own members.
