

Mozambique: MNR accepts Moi as mediator with government The MNR has accepted the offer by President Moi of Kenya to mediate in negotiations to end the civil war in Mozambique, according to SABC-TV, citing an MNR statement issued in Lisbon. The statement said that the MNR also supported the formation of a 'group of African heads of state to participate in the peace process. It added that MNR leader Afonso Dhlakama was prepared to meet a Mozambican government delegation under the chairmanship of President Moi.

According to Capital Radio (Umtata) on 26th July, the MNR has attacked a suburb of Maputo, killing at least three civilians. The radio said that the Portuguese agency had reported that the attack was on Beneficia suburb shortly after midnight on 25th July. A group of about 250 rebels had also tried to sabotage an electricity relay station nearby, but had been fought off by security forces. Capital Radio said that the Portuguese agency had cited "an unnamed military source" for its report of the incident. 1989
