Church leaders set for Nairobi talks with MNR Sistan

A MOZAMBIQUE church delegation left this Monday for Nairobi for talks with representatives of the rebel Mozambique National Resistance Movement (MNR/ Renamo).

The delegation consisted of the Archbishop of Maputo, Cardinal Alexandre Maria dos Santos, and the Presbyterian pastor, Mucache; they were followed by Catholic Bishop of Beira Jaime Goncalves.

According to a spokesperson for the rebel organisation, its leader Afonso Dhlakama would be attending the

talks.

Mozambique's President Joaquim Chissano meanwhile dismissed the 16-point document drawn up by the MNR as a basis for talks.
