Mozambique: MNR reports arrival of Cuban Radiodifusao Portuguesa (Lisbon) reported the MNR's representative in the Portuguese capital, Manuel Frank, as announcing on 2nd September that a contingent of 595 black Cuban soldiers arrived in Maputo on 25th and 26th August, and that more were likely to arrive on 9th and 10th September. Frank said the arrival of the Cuban troops would complicate the current peace negotiations and indicated that President Chissano intended to continue the war. The MNR statement was also reported by AFP which said it claimed that some of the Cuban soldiers had been part of the Cuban military contingent currently being withdrawn from Angola. 1949
