

Mozambican President may meet Moi and Mugabe in Nairobi

As the eighth summit of the heads of state of the Preferential Trade Area (PTA) member countries opened in Nairobi on 30th November, observers stated that current efforts for peace in Mozambique might be discussed at a possible meeting between the Presidents of Mozambique, Kenya and Zimbabwe, Radio Mozambique (Maputo) reported that day, noting that President Chissano had chosen Presidents Moi and Mugabe as mediators in the Mozambique peace process.

A later report issued by the radio stated that rumours that MNR leaders had arrived in Nairobi on the 30th to meet President Chissano were denied by a government delegate to the PTA summit; such a meeting would imply recognition of the MNR, the PTA source said.
