

MNR man to 'see Chissano'

LISBON. ^{1/2} **MOZAMBICAN** bandits ¹² said yesterday their chief ⁴ planned to visit Nairobi at the same time as President Joaquim Chissano and wanted to discuss moves to end a decade of conflict.

Manuel Frank, Lisbon spokesman for the MNR bandits, said bandit leader Afonso Dhlakama hoped to arrive in the Kenyan capital later yesterday and was willing to

meet President Chissano, who is attending a PTA summit.

"We would like direct contact with the government, a meeting with Cde Chissano is possible but nothing has been set up," said the spokesman.

He said Dhlakama would probably meet Kenyan and Zimbabwean officials who have offered to mediate in the peace process. — Ziana-Reuter.
