

Presidents of Kenya and Zimbabwe sign "secret agreement" on Mozambique (ME/0635 ii) Presidents Moi and Mugabe, mediators in the Mozambique conflict, are reported by the Zimbabwean agency to have signed a "secret agreement" on Mozambique during talks in Nairobi on 8th December, the Pan-African agency reported on the 10th. According to the Kenyan agency, also on the 10th, the agreement was signed after four hours of consultative talks reviewing the peace process. Although no details of the agreement were disclosed, a Zimbabwean government official said that "definite progress" had been made. The general news black-out was being interpreted as an indication that progress had been made, the agency added. 1989
