

# Mozambique peace talks to resume

THE Mozambican government and the MNR bandits will soon continue direct secret talks in Malawi or Lisbon, the Portugese Prime Minister, Mr Anibal Cavaco Silva, has said.

Mr Silva told The Herald recently in Lisbon that the venue of the talks was still to be decided because while the Mozambican government preferred Malawi, the bandits had countered with Lisbon.

The Mozambican government and the bandits recently met in Lisbon for direct talks at a secret venue. The talks were sponsored by Portugal. Portugal also hosted, almost at the same time, secret talks between Angola and Unita. Both Angola and Mozambique were former Portugese colonies.
