

Malawi venue for talks H.

THE Mozambican president, Cde Joaquim Chissano, declared in Maputo yesterday some of the leadership of the MNR bandits are interested in misinforming the international community, on the agreed venue for the talks with the government, and in arguing against dialogue for peace.

Cde Chissano was speaking at a tree-planting ceremony which marked the 10th anniversary of the foundation of the Mozambican Friendship and Solidarity Association, AMASP.

Cde Chissano reaffirmed that the bandits have agreed that Malawi should host peace talks between them-

selves and the Mozambican government.

The venue for the talks has been a stumbling block since April, when Cde Chissano first announced that the government was proposing Malawi.

The bandits immediately rejected the proposal without giving reasons. — Ziana-Pana-AIM.
