

Raul Domingos criticises excessive optimism

Renamo Head of External Relations Raul Manuel Domingos has declared that a December date for a cease-fire may be too optimistic. He was reacting to comments made by the Italian delegate to the recent Rome talks between his organization and the Mozambican government.

Domingos added that "great differences" still exist between both sides, saying that FRELIMO remains "inflexible" on the issue of the one-party state.

Commenting on the role of the Churches in the Rome meeting, Domingos said that they had facilitated the mediation process but should not be considered as mediators.
