Renamo 'still attacking in Beira Corridor'

MAPUTO. — Renamo continues to violate its undertaking not to make attacks inside the Beira and Limpopo corridors, according to a Beira newspaper.

The newspaper, *Diario de Mocambique*, says that since the rebel movement signed the Rome agreement on December 1 it has been violated at least 11 times in the Beira Corridor.

The agreement provides for Renamo to make no further attacks inside the corridors and for the Zimbabwean troops which have been operating against Renamo in Mozambique to be confined to the corridors.

According to the Beira newspaper, Renamo has sabotaged the Beira Corridor railway three times since December 1.
