Delegation off for more talks

MAPUTO. — A Mozambican delegation left Maputo on Wednesday night for the fifth round of peace talks with the MNR bandits in Rome.

The third round of talks last November culminated in the signing of an agreement on December 1 under which Zimbabwean forces in Mozambique were restricted to the two rail corridors linking Zimbabwe to the ports of Maputo and Beira, and the bandits undertook not to attack those corridors.

Little progress was registered in the fourth round of talks. — Ziana-Aim-Pana.
