

Talks delay

Maputo (AFP) — The next round of peace talks between the Mozambican government and the Renamo rebels scheduled for today has been postponed to 2 May, President Chissano has announced. Mr Chissano said the postponement was at Renamo's request. He expressed scepticism as to whether the rebels were at all serious about the peace talks, which have been under way sporadically in Rome since July 1990.
