Mozambican peace talks to resume on 10th July The mediators at the Rome peace talks had informed the Mozambican government that the negotiation process would resume on 10th July, rather than 1st July, as had been planned, Radio Mozambique (Maputo) reported on 29th June, citing the Mozambican agency. The mediators felt that the delay in resuming the talks was necessary in order that both sides might make the contacts needed in order to tackle existing difficulties, Radio Maputo said, also on 29th June.
