A MOZAMBICAN bandit leader hoped on Thursday that the on-going Rome peace talks will bring forth a workable peace process towards early general election in Mozambique.

Addressing a Press conference, Afonso Dhlakama, head of MNR bandits said: "We are tired of military fighting against our brothers in the Mozambican government."

"What we want in Mozambique is justice and freedom of movement and speech," said Dhlakama who is currently in Kenya.

The only support which Kenya gives to the bandits is the initiative to enter into dialogue with the Mozambican ruling party Frelimo to seek for peaceful solutions to the problems facing Mozambique, Dhlakama added. — Ziana-Xinhua.
