

Mozambique peace talks resume

ROME.

THE ninth round of Mozambique peace talks in Rome, Italy, aimed at ending the country's 16-year conflict, began yesterday, mediators said.

Delegates from the government and the MNR bandits spent the morning discussing agreements reached last month on the creation of political parties, a short statement from the religious community of Sant' Egidio said.

The talks, being mediated by the Italian government, Sant' Egidio and other Catholic churchmen, were due to resume later yesterday, the statement said. —
