Renamo election idea

The Mozambican government delegation at the tenth round of peace talks in Rome last week described Renamo proposals on a future electoral law as "negative and inadequate".

Among the disagreements is a Renamo proposal to outlaw the formation of coalitions between political parties either before or after the holding of elections.

Renamo is also calling for a high threshold of 18% of the vote before a party could win seats in the future parliament. [Agencies]
