## Moz ceasefire due to take effect tomorrow

MAPUTO. — Mozambique's ceasefire is due to take effect tomorrow when an advance team of observers

should be in place, says the UN.

The UN team, headed by a special representative appointed by the secretary-general, Dr Boutros Boutros-Ghali, would include "25 military observers and necessary administrative support staff", said a

statement yesterday.

It said the first team was small because of the limited time available, but would be followed by more people who would carry out all the functions envisaged for the UN under a peace agreement signed by the Mozambican government and Renamo rebels on October 4.

The announcement followed ratification of the peace pact by the Mozambican parliament on Mon-
