

Frelimo meets over ceasefire

MAPUTO. — Mozambique's ruling Frelimo party is meeting here this week to bolster the country's fragile ceasefire and map the party's strategy for free elections next year.

President Joaquim Chissano urged his party, when he opened the five-day meeting, to help prevent a resumption of civil war.

Frelimo and Renamo have accused each other of ceasefire violations, but President Chissano seems optimistic the truce will hold. — Sapa-Reuter
