Pamphlets a threat to peace

MAPUTO — An unknown group calling'
itself the "Green Helmets" has circulated
leaflets in Maputo threatening to launch
attacks in Mozambique five months after a
peace accord ended 16 years of civil war.
Delivered anonymously to local journalists,
the leaflets threatened to start ambushes to
cut off roads this week. The leaflets indicated
the major grievance of the group was that

the government and the opposition Renamo movement were not looking after demobilised fighters from both sides, but enriching themselves. — Sapa-Reuter
