

Guardsmen overpowered

MAPUTO— Seven mutineers were wounded when commandos stormed the barracks of the Mozambican presidential guard in an outer Maputo suburb on Tuesday, according to a government statement published this week. The commandos overpowered the guardsmen, who mutinied over pay and demobilisation benefits, and took control of the barracks using light arms in an operation that lasted about half an hour. — Sapa-AFP
