Renamo stalls on assembly points plans

RENAMO is yet to submit the names of their com-manders who would be in charge of their forces at its 20 UN-administered assembly points in Mozambique.

Mr Ton Pardoel, head of the demobilisation technical unit of the United Nations Operation in Mozambique, was quoted by Tha Domingo newspaper yesterday as saying that the full list of government troops' commanders for its 29 assembly points had, however, been received.

Soldiers of Renamo and the government are to assemble at UN-administered points prior to demobilisation or incorporation into the Mozambican Defence Force (FADM).

Under the timetable for a return to multi-party democracy, the movement to assembly points is to begin on November 30. - Ziana-Aim- Pana
