## Renamo end dispute

MAPUTO.

THE Mozambican government and Renamo organisation have ended a dispute which threatened to wreck plans for multi-party elections next October, UN special envoy Mr Aldo Ajello said yesterday.

"The impasse on electoral law seems to have been overcome," he said at his weekly Press briefing in Maputo.

The compromise deal gives Renamo increased representation, but less than it had been demanding on local electoral commissions and on the technical secretariat of the national electoral commission.

The agreement was reached between President Joaquim Chissano and Renamo leader Mr Afonso Dhlakama at talks here on Wednesday.

The crucial negotiations passed largely unnoticed because of rioting in the capital over bus fare increases in which one person was killed and at least 55 injured. —
