

Soldiers in Moz revolt

MAPUTO. — Government soldiers in Angoche mutinied yesterday, according to reports by the national Radio Mocambique.

The radio said hundreds of soldiers gathered at a UN-supervised assembly area in Angoche and began to march towards the provincial capital in Nam-pula, demanding immediate demobilisation.

Soldiers are angry at delays to the demobilisation provided for under an agreement to end Mozambique's civil war.
