Council could help Mozambique complete ts democratic transition even after its nandate ends in December. UN special envoy Aldo Ajello has said.

In a testimony on the outcome of his wo years as chief of the UN mission here, Mr Ajello said: "A strong government will obviously be the most potent antidote to var, and could complete the unfinished asks (of the peace process)."

Mr Ajello said his mission had been successful in overseeing the achievement of two years of peace, demobilising two rival armies and turning guerrilla Renamo into political force.
